## Masks do not cause self-contamination

Panhandle total: 479, Active: 56, Recovered: 417, Deaths: 6

Masks do not cause self-contamination. The idea that wearing a mask after you've been exposed to COVID-19 will increase your level of infection, is a myth. There is no evidence to support this self-contamination claim.

Unified Command confirms ten more cases of COVID-19 in the Panhandle. The investigations are complete, all close contacts will be quarantined and actively monitored for symptoms by public health officials.
