Two recent incidents show the value of mask-wearing as a critical prevention tool Panhandle total: 504, Active: 64, Recovered: 434, Deaths: 6

If a person is confirmed positive for COVID-19 and has been in close contact with another person, as long as both individuals are wearing a mask, the positive case will be required to self-isolate and the close contact will not be required to self-quarantine only monitor for symptoms.

This continues to stress the importance of mask-wearing, especially when social distancing is difficult to maintain. Two recent school incidents have conveyed the importance of mask-wearing. Had this critical COVID-19 prevention tool not been implemented, it could have delayed the start of school because a large number of staff would have been required to self-quarantine.

Unified Command confirms fifteen more cases of COVID-19 in the Panhandle. The investigations are complete, all close contacts will be quarantined and actively monitored for symptoms by public health officials.
