Stay safe at the voting polls on Election Day

Panhandle total: 2,780; Active: 1,241; Recovered: 1,586; Deaths: 16

There are steps you can take to help you vote and minimize your risk during the COVID pandemic. The more prepared you are, the less time you may have to spend at the voting site.

When voting, protect yourself and others:

- Keep a distance of at least 6 feet away from other people
- Wear a mask
- Bring your own pen
- Wash or sanitize your hands

Unified Command confirms 534 more cases of COVID in the Panhandle and 159 recoveries since last reporting on Thursday, October 29. The investigations are underway, all close contacts will be quarantined.
